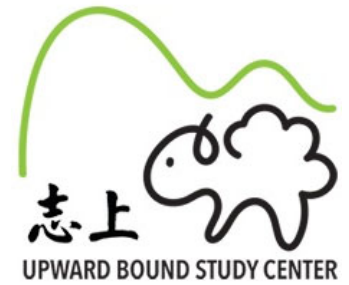

East West Bank Foundation, in partnership with the Upward Bound Study Center, is committed to providing financial resources to assist college-bound students in the communities we serve. Each scholarship is in the amount of \$500.

Eligibility Requirements

- Be a graduating high school senior
- Have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale
- Be a U.S. citizen, legal permanent resident, or eligible non-U.S. citizen
- Be pursuing higher education at an accredited and non-profit four-year college or university, junior college, or technical/trade school
- Demonstrate the following:
 - Financial need
 - Ability to overcome adversity
 - Commitment to community service

Application Package

- Scholarship Application Form
- Personal statement
- Cumulative high school official transcript including GPA

Deadlines & Important Dates

- Application deadline: April 30, 2022
- Award notifications: May 14, 2022
- Award ceremony: May 21, 2022

Rules

- Awards will be distributed in the form of a check made payable to the recipient and the school selected by the recipient.
- Awards must be redeemed within 2 years of distribution date.
- Recipients are selected by a scholarship committee composed of members from Upward Bound Study Center.
- Applicants related to a member of the scholarship committee are ineligible.
- Scholarship funds will be paid during the month of **August 2022**—**directly to the college**, not the student. Awards will be distributed in the form of a check made payable to the recipient and the school selected by the recipient.
- Applications must be received by Upward Bound Study Center no later than **April 30, 2022**. Late applications will not be accepted.

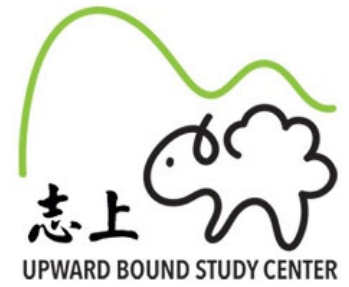
